Bharatanatyam

Classical Indian dance with a harmonious blend of expressions (Bhava), melody (Raga) and rhythm (Thala) while Natyam means dance. In Bharatanatyam, the dancer is a story teller and the language is of hand gestures, facial expressions and rhythmic footwork. Classical Indian dance classes are a great way of improving your fitness level, flexibility and strength. Explore Indian culture while keeping fit!

General Level – class designed for anyone above 14 years old with minimum of 2 years of previous Bharatanatyam training

Beginners (Adults) – class designed for anyone above 14 years old class and suitable for complete beginners and those with some experience

Beginners (Children) – class designed for children under 14 years old with no previous dance experience and for those at a beginner level

Bharatanatyam Repertoire (Children) – designed for young dancers up to the age of 14 years old with minimum of two years of Bharatanatyam training. Weekly classes are designed to prepare the individual young dancer to work within a body of dancers, orientating themselves in relation to them, and particularly to hold and move from one geometric pattern to another

Classical Indian Dance

This course is designed to introduce the basic techniques of classical Indian dance, in particular Bharatanatyam. Yoga exercises are incorporated in the warm-up. Suitable for any one above 16 years old with no previous or little experience of classical Indian dance forms.

Bollywood

Blending together traditions of folk and classical dances from India, this course will introduce you to the contemporary Indian dance. Classes are highly energetic and will improve your concentration, endurance and overall physical fitness. A fun way to sculpt your body and learn new dance moves to Indian film music. Classes are suitable for anyone above 16 years old. No previous experience is required.

Yoga

Course developed by Priya Shrikumar, Artistic Director of Dance Ihayami, as a means of merging together classical Indian dance and yoga. Suitable for anyone above 18 years old.
